HVFC: Annual Children's Christmas Party With Santa – A Joyful Evening!

On December 17, nearly 70 local children shared their Christmas wish lists with Santa during Haddam Volunteer Fire Company's Annual Children's Christmas Party.

After Santa arrived at the firehouse on Engine 1-13, he greeted each family before taking his seat in the community hall. There, each child had a chance speak with Santa and receive a gift. Families also were treated to Christmas cookies and refreshments and the HVFC Auxiliary held a basket raffle to help offset the costs of the party.

The Children's Christmas Party may be the most long-standing tradition in the fire company's history. For more than 90 years, volunteers have worked to host the gathering, which began at the town green in the 1930s. According to Company Historian and Firefighter Teresa Kuchyt, life members recall giving children apples as presents.

When Haddam Volunteer Fire Company acquired its newest firehouse in 2001, its members, with help of the HVFC Auxiliary, began hosting the party at this new building on Saybrook Road. More than 30 volunteers, spearheaded by the HVFC's Christmas Committee, participate in the annual event and assist with decorating the firehouse, wrapping gifts, setting up, and hosting the party, which lasts for approximately two hours.

"The Children's Christmas Party is one of the fire company's most fun-filled events, not only for the children, but for us as members," said Christmas Committee Chair and Firefighter Malcolm Meyer. "It's wonderful that members of both the fire company and our auxiliary can work together to bring so much joy to several families in the community."

Guilford Professional Firefighters are specially trained in many specialized emergency capabilities including high angle rescue. A report of a hiker and their dog slid off a 40 foot cliff and the dog was stranded on a small ledge halfway down the cliff.

Killingworth Fire Department was in the scene and special called Guilford Professional Firefighters to respond. Upon their arrival they set up a special rope system to reach the dog and performed a rescue to lower the dog safely to the ground.



New Laws Taking Effect in Connecticut on January 1, 2023

With a new year comes new laws going into effect after work completed in recent years by legislators at the State Capitol. Among the new state laws to go into effect in 2023 are several policies to support children's health and wellness:

- The state's "Bottle Bill" receives its first significant update in decades, with redemptions expanded to include teas, hard seltzers, ciders, energy drinks and coffee. This comes as, at the start of 2024, bottles and cans will see their redemption value double from 5 cents to 10 cents per can and bottle.
- Testing for lead poisoning will increase, part of an effort to reduce the presence of lead in children, which can harm their development. In 2020, just over 1,000 children in Connecticut had lead concentration in their blood, but only 178 of

them would have had their homes inspected to find sources of lead; this new law will help protect children's health.

- Certain health insurance carriers will be required to provide explanations of benefits to members.
- Children's mental health will be supported through the use of screening tools to diagnose mental, behavioral and potential substance use

disorders in children.

- Certain health care providers will be required to expand coverage requirements for specified procedures to treat or prevent breast or ovarian cancer.

Update: Haddam Board of Selectmen December 12 Meeting

The regular meeting of Haddam's Board of Selectmen on December 12, at Town Hall was called to order by First Selectman Bob McGarry at 6:35 p.m. Selectmen Kate Anderson and Sean Moriarty and Administrative Assistant JoAnn Ricciardelli were in attendance.

The minutes of the previous meeting on November 14, 2022, were approved unanimously.

First Selectman McGarry announced that the Town of Haddam will receive \$1.5 million for environmental clean-up of the Rossi property. Sale of Scovil Hoe closed on November 21, 2022. Traffic cameras on the Swing Bridge are installed and should be live by Christmas. The feed will be on the Swing Bridge project website. A change order

to install approximately 100 feet of round rail fence by the steep drop from Bridge Road sidewalk to the road just east of Camp Bethel Road is under review. Beaver Meadow Road has reopened. All that is remaining of the Haddam Center sidewalk project are signs, pedestals, rapid flashing beacons and crosswalk markings.

Selectman Anderson recognized the Tylerville Tree Lighting as a success and thanked all the volunteers and Public Works for decorating the town. The Holiday Pop-Up Market is still going strong. There are openings on the Economic Development Committee. She also made a motion to accept tax refunds in the amount of \$31,057.09; the motion carried unanimously.

Colleen Totman, Senior Center Activities

Coordinator, resigned effective December 15, 2022, and Daun Kowalski, Animal Control Officer, is resigning effective February 1, 2023. Selectman Moriarty made a motion to appoint Emily Kyle to the Haddam Parks & Recreation Commission; the motion carried unanimously.

The Higganum Cove Master Plan received an award from the Connecticut Chapter of the American Planning Association.

The next regular Board of Selectmen meeting is scheduled for Monday, January 9, 2023, at 6:30 p.m. The meeting adjourned at 7:04 p.m.

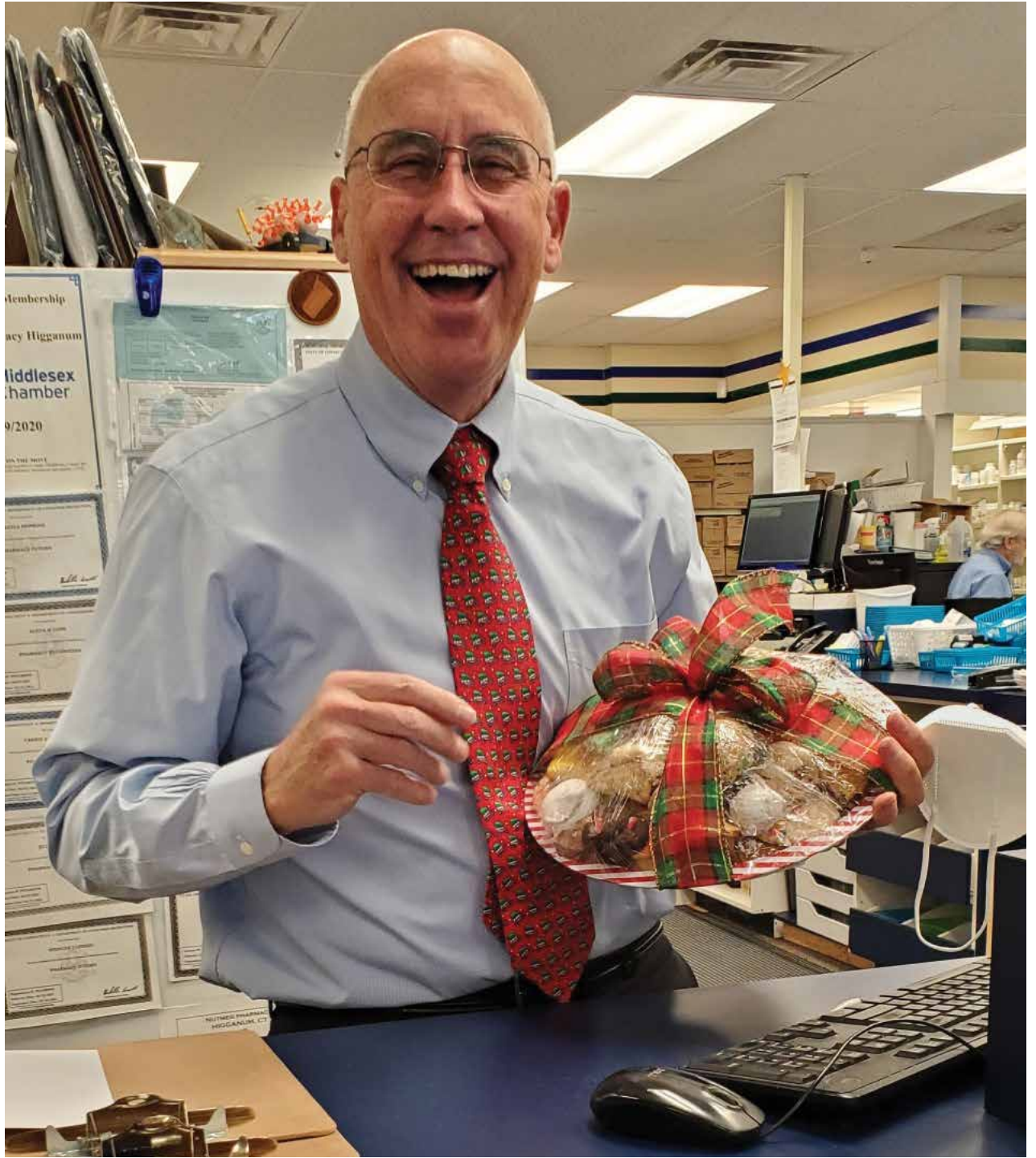
